This session stems from the wish to establish long-term collaboration on Science-Impacts-Society and Multi-scale Climate-Air-Water Nexus for Sustainable Health, Food, and Energy. Climate scientists and impact representatives/stakeholders from various sectors will discuss real information needs and explore a pilot project to develop tailored training for key groups (e.g., decision-makers, students, marginalized communities). The pilot project will highlight the value of cross-disciplinary collaboration and include components such as trust-building excercises and knowledge exchange.
