


We wish you a healthy and prosperous 2023!!

Dear colleagues,

The new year has started and will offer many exciting WCRP and CORDEX activities and events. Below we inform and remind about some of those and we will continue to keep you posted on what is coming during the year.

As you probably know by now The 5th CORDEX conference, ICRC-CORDEX 2023, will
take place in Trieste, Italy and in Pune, India, as well as online 25-29 September 2023.
Please find the preliminary timeline here. The draft programme overview looks like

- At the WCRP Open Science Conference in Kigali, Rwanda, 23-27 October 2023
 CORDEX will arrange and be part of several side events, more info on this will come.
- · Deadline extended for new CMIP7 Data Access Task Team!

The demand for and interest in CMIP data is growing rapidly with users coming from an increasingly diverse range of backgrounds beyond the climate research community including climate services, impact modelling, regional and local policy/decision makers and indigenous communities from across the globe. This task team will seek to smooth the path between the conception of experiments and the use of the resulting data. We are looking for a diverse and multidisciplinary team of 8-12 experts representing the range of CMIP-like data providers, data users, and infrastructure providers. We are especially keen to ensure representation from all global regions and across career stages and have therefore extended the call deadline to promote wider participation.  (TPE) under Global Changes is very relevant for the Third Pole FPS.
